Turing- Have been working with equations and calculations in Science, building an understanding of what the different variables represent and developing substitution skills.

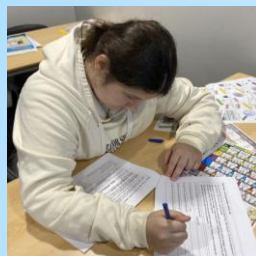
Eilish- Have been exploring WWI propaganda and poetry in English and understanding the importance of Remembrance Day in PSHRE.
